### Scenario 7.1b

- Scenario rules say the *French win if Kutuzov is eliminated*.
- Replace with the Russian player takes 2 Demoralizations if Kutuzov is eliminated.

#### Scenario 7.2c

- Scenario rules say the Coalition player wins if the Allied player is demoralized by the end of turn 6. Any other result is a French victory.
- Replace with the Coalition player wins if the **French** player is demoralized by the end of turn 6. Any other result is a French victory.

# Scenario 7.2c, Leipzig Set-up Sheet, October 18th

- *Clarification:* The Russian IX corps in Wing C is the XI Corps
- Clarification: The Russian XI/X corps in the Silesia Reserve is the IX/X Corps

# Scenario 7.1b (Crossing the Kalocha River)

• *Addition*: while the Kalocha river terrain card is out of play, flanked cards are not placed in the Kalocha River wing.

#### Scenario 7.2c (Crossing the Pleisse River)

• *Addition:* while the Pleisse river terrain card is out of play, flanked cards are not placed in the Pleisse River win

# Rule 4.8 Ending a Battle

• Addition: "If the defeated wing is empty, both of unit cards and terrain cards, a flanked card is placed in it (*if there is not one there already*), *one demoralization is inflicted on the defeated player*, and breakthrough attacks are resolved.

### **Rule 4.10 Flanking**

• Remove: "Place a Flanked card in the wing as a reminder."
